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# Step 1: Use Online Catalog

When you visit our library, the library online catalog (OPAC) would be a essential tool to find materials. By using OPAC, you can search all the materials HU libraries have. The information of the material can be printed out as a request memo.

- If you want a material at Closed Stacks, please ask the library staff.
- Graduates, staff, and undergraduates who have already taken a guidance tour of the Closed Stacks can enter and pick the materials all by yourselves. Please make sure that you put your belongings in a locker before entering the Closed Stacks.

When you search for materials in the library, location and call numbers are important. The call number indicates the location of materials and consists of certain numbers and alphabet. All books in the library are aligned in accordance with this call number.
