#### 3F: Open Stacks


(Computer science, information & general works, Philosophy & psychology, Religion)


#### 4F: Open Stacks

## Computers

There are computers on the second and third floor. Students or staff who have their own ID are able to use them freely. Please bring an USB flash drive when you want to save your data or documents.

# Wireless Network (Wi-Fi)

Hokkaido University provides students and staff free Wi-Fi called HINES-WLAN. It is available in the library as well.

# **Copy Machines**

We offer two copy machines on the second and fourth floor, respectively. You can print out documents through a USB flash drive with a copy machine on the second floor (only A4 sized PDF documents are available in this case).



# **Individual Study Booth**


## Full-closed (6 booths available)

Since it blocks sounds, you are allowed to talk in the booth (i.e. taking online classes or online interview). Make sure to book before use.

## Semi-closed (11 booths available)

Since it does not block sounds completely, you are not allowed to talk or make noise in the booth. Booking is only needed when you use the one that is accessible to anyone.

No booking needed when you use ten other semi-closed ones.









## Third Floor (Entrance Bldg.)

The vending machine and some leaflets are available on the third floor of the Entrance building (you can go to this floor, taking stairs right before the entrance gate).

The lounge space on the same floor where you can eat and drink is currently closed due to COVID-19.

## Media Court

This area opens during 11 am and 3 pm on weekdays only. You are allowed to eat and drink here. Vending machine is also available downstairs.

In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19, we are currently saving space in the Media Court. Please keep the social distance while eating.
