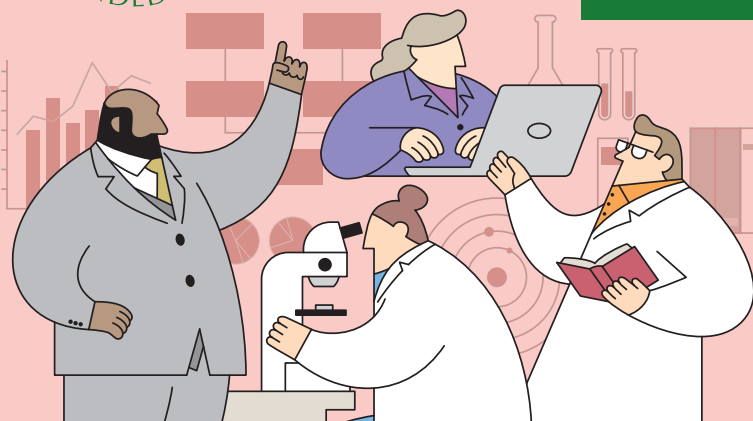

Starting with new applications for FY2025, immediate open access (OA) of articles and research data funded by certain public grants will be mandatory.

OPEN ACCESS with HUSCAP

Public grants subject to OA mandate

JSPS	(Japan Society for the Promotion of Science)	Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research (KAKENHI)
JST	(Japan Science and Technology Agency)	Strategic Basic Research Programs (with some exceptions)
AMED	(Japan Agency for Medical Research and Development)	Advanced Research & Development Programs for Medical Innovation
JST	(Japan Science and Technology Agency)	Fusion Oriented Research for disruptive Science and Technology

Making articles and research data OA

There are a few ways to make your articles and research data OA. One is to post them to an institutional repository (self-archive). Another is to pay an article processing charge (APC) to an online journal to ensure they are OA. **Researchers affiliated with Hokkaido University can comply with the OA mandate by posting their academic articles and research data to HUSCAP, Hokkaido University's Institutional Repository.** An appropriate version of your paper can be uploaded to HUSCAP after the embargo period. With regards to publishing on HUSCAP as a self-archive, the Hokkaido University Library will check the copyright regulations of the publisher to ensure all requirements are met.

What is subject to the OA Mandate?

- Academic Articles:** Peer-reviewed articles published in online journals (publisher's version or author's final manuscript)
- Research data:** Research data required to ensure transparency and reproducibility when submitting a paper to an online journal (supplemental data and other data that is assumed to be published)

What does immediate OA refer to?

Immediate OA refers to open access without an embargo period after publication in an academic journal. The general standard with this kind of OA is to open articles on an institutional repository within about 3 months of publication in an online academic journal. Depending on whether the publisher has stipulated an embargo period or not, OA publication may be postponed.

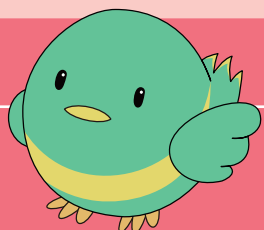
What should be my first step in making my articles and research data OA?

First, you need to check whether your articles and research data are subject to the OA mandate. It is important that you keep all final manuscripts that were accepted for publishing after peer review. Next, send them to the HUSCAP team at the Hokkaido University Library.

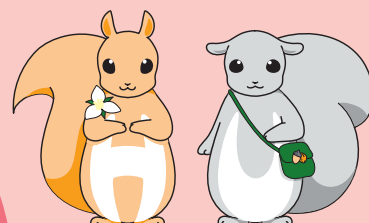

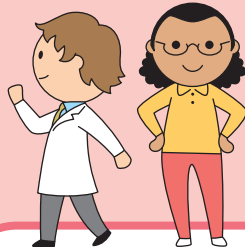
