Reference information about the Creative Commons CC0 public domain dedication

The copyrights of English abstracts registered as metadata in HUSCAP are subject to the Creative Commons CC0 public domain dedication, which allows others to use the abstracts in any form. CC0 is a license that allows copyright holders to indicate that their works, which are normally subject to copyright, may be used by others without restriction. For example, when CC0 is applied, the Japan Link Center, which issues DOIs for research reports and journal articles, can allow any third party to freely use the metadata, including English abstracts.

All bibliographic information, such as the manuscript title, author name(s), and journal name of papers registered with HUSCAP, as well as abstracts of publications assigned a DOI, are subject to CC0, including the Bulletin and Memoirs.

If the authors do not agree to the application of CC0 to the English abstract, it will not be registered as metadata in HUSCAP.
